Abstract Submission	<p>Participants are invited to submit abstracts pertaining to the topics in the program schedule. Abstracts will be accepted for oral or poster presentations. Poster-based abstracts will be presented throughout the course and participants will also have an opportunity to review them during the poster sessions.</p>
Abstract Guidelines	<p>Deadline for submission is January 15, 2010. Please submit your abstract via e-mail to: pcrrt2010@opbg.net. Only abstracts written in English will be accepted. Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent within January 22, 2010, via e-mail, so it is imperative that email address is included in abstract submission.</p> <p>Each abstract should be prepared on a separate page using 10 point type in an area measuring 8.5 cm/3.35 inches wide and 10.5 cm/4.13 inches high. Recommended font is Times New Roman. Do not put a box around the text.</p> <p>Title – 10 point type, bold</p> <p>Author names – new line, 9 point, caps and lower case, initials for first names (do not add Prof., Dr., etc.)</p> <p>Text – 9 point, single type, include figures and tables within text in 8 point. Do not use line spaces between paragraphs.</p> <p>Affiliation – At the end of each abstract leave a blank line, then type address, fax and email of the first author and the institution where the research work was done.</p>

The Bambino Gesù Children's Hospital would like to inform you that legislative Decree N. 196 of June the 30th ("Code about personal data protection") sets a series of regulations to assure personal data protection.
