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Dear Colleagues,

This edition of the VIII National Congress of the Italian Society for Cleft Lip and Palate and Craniofacial Malformation Study and Treatment will be significantly different. It was decided to give an international outlook to the convention because the treatment of Craniofacial diseases, although different protocols are used in different countries, has nonetheless reached considerable results in quality and accessibility of treatment.

The international speakers who have been invited will contribute to further enhance the level of a considerably high profile scientific debate.

Our panel of speakers have been asked to present their topics in a user friendly and effective manner in order to facilitate the comparisons between protocols and techniques. This aims to provide even the younger surgeons, who are new to approach this highly specialized discipline, with the chance to both understand the philosophy and rationale behind different diagnostic treatments, and appreciate the quality of the results.

Free sessions, in line with the scientific spirit that pervades the convention will be dedicated to doctors who have been exposed to craniofacial malformations and who would like to compare their experiences, even on single cases, with colleagues, with the belief that such comparison will offer new ideas and motivation to increase knowledge in the field.

The first part of the congress is dedicated to training of craniofacial malformations' specialists. EPLS (European Pediatric Life Support) courses for surgeons, dentists and nurses are supported by Operation Smile. These courses will provide basic information for those doctors and nurses who intend to develop experience and learn about voluntary work in the field.

Furthermore, the Fondazione Operation Smile Italia Onlus, on the occasion of the Congress will organize one full morning Symposium devoted to worldwide humanitarian organizations treating children suffering from craniofacial malformations, this meeting will be under the auspices of the Presidency of the Chamber of Deputies, and will take place in Palazzo Montecitorio, on 22nd September, 2011.

The official inauguration of the VIII SILPS National Congress will take place at 17:00 on 22nd September, at the Dentistry and Craniofacial Sciences Department of "Sapienza" University of Rome, that will host the entire scientific work on 23rd and 24th September, 2011.

The SILPS Board of Directors has agreed to hold the Congress to honor the memory of Dr. Renzo Giuliani, a source of inspiration for generations of colleagues. Dr. Giuliani was not only an example of professional competence and discipline, but he also transmitted an incredible humanitarian spirit that accompanied him till the very end of his life, which he dedicated to the poor, the weak and the forgotten people.

We are all hoping to welcome you in Rome!
